

## Grant Stock for ScoutingTrain

The fee for every participant (Conductor, Traveller) of the ScoutingTrain including Stay in Moscow 1.-5.th August, travel with three stops and camp in Irkutsk and participation at wagon meeting including travel-expenses and program and stay) is 500 EUR per Person. Each person has to finance additionally the travel to Moscow and the travel back from Irkutsk.

**Important:** in this individual sums are next to the stay in Moscow (1st of August to 5th of August, also the travel from Moscow to Irkutsk with 3 stops (2 of them with one overnight in Perm and Novosibirsk and 3 days of camp in the area of Lake Baikal) included. Also included is the participation (including travel expenses, stay and program) at one wagon meeting, which is organized in the responsibility of wagons.

The **registration fee** can't be paid back in case of cancellation of the travel by the participant. It includes the participation of one wagon meeting. The **travel fee** is about 500 EUR minus 150 EUR registration fee, has to be paid if the person can travel with us.

To make it more clear we have here a few examples:

### Example 1: arrival from Poland or Germany

## Example 5: arrival from Hungarian

## Example 6: travel from Siberia

Registration fee	EUR	150,00

Travel back home from Irkutsk by train (Irkutsk – Omsk)	EUR	50,00
Personal Expenses	EUR	50,00

For some travellers in our wagons this seems to be very much money or not achievable.

The Executive Board did already a lot of fund sourcing in the time before - because the real costs for our project are much more higher.

**Our Goal is to bring all travellers and conductors – irrespective of their social background - to Lake Baikal - so we decided to install a fund with money from donors from which we give grants from 100 to 750 EUR to those who need financial support.**

**Important:** The stipendiums can only be applied by people (conductors or travellers) which are active in the project and support the project to succeed.

Everyone should know that the stipendiums are part of our budget and should be used only if help is needed and only in the size which is needed.

Everyone who is accepted as traveller or conductor from one wagon can apply for stipendiums. As faster as you apply for the money and as strong you describe your motivation rather you get a positive answer.

The application has to be sent formless to [stipendia@scoutingtrain.org](mailto:stipendia@scoutingtrain.org) and it will be trustfully executed by Benjamin Spatz (member of Executive Board) and a trust person from BdP - the wagons will not be informed about this.

### Content of application has to be:

- Wagon affiliation
- Short explanation about personal situation in economical sphere
- Motivation why participation at ScoutingTrain is important
- Concrete planned action how the applicator wants to support the wagon, which tasks is he or she doing (e.g. translations, doing events to promote ScoutingTrain etc.)
- Calculation of individual costs and own contribution (including the travel from home to Moscow, from Irkutsk home)
- Sum of asked money (100 to maximum 750 EUR per person)

**Important:** we only will give out grants to participants, who will come to the wagon meetings and paid 150 EUR registration fee .

The out payment will be done normally by reducing the 350 EUR outstanding payment or by booking a ticket back from Irkutsk.
